License Grant Information

1. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC), issues ARS Licenses with '**Two Grants**' together. They are both issued on the same license document.
 - a. The **First Grant** is the **Primary Station License Grant (PSLG)**.
 - i. It is the assigned '**Primary Station Call Sign**'.
 - b. The **Second Grant** is the **Amateur Operator License Grant (AOLG)**.
 - i. It '**Assigns the Person Named**' on the grant license as the '**Control Operator**' of the Primary Station.
 - ii. It '**Authorizes the Person Named**' on the grant license with specific '**Amateur Operator Privileges**' for which they passed after taking the appropriate examination.
 - c. The different '**Amateur Operator Privileges**' for specific Operator Class Examinations are:
 - i. Novice Class (**no longer issued, current license renewals only**)
 - ii. Technician Class
 - iii. General Class
 - iv. Advanced Class (**no longer issued, current license renewals only**)
 - v. Amateur Extra Class
